


Uploading observations to iNaturalist – Report Roadkill BC

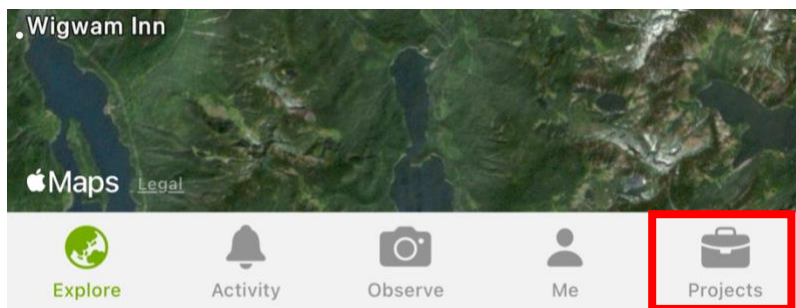
Before you upload observations, you can join the [Report Roadkill BC Members Only project](#). Here are instructions on how to do that:

If you do not have the iNaturalist app, download it for free from the App Store or Google Play. Once you've downloaded it, it will prompt you to sign in or create an account. If you do not have an account, you can make one now.

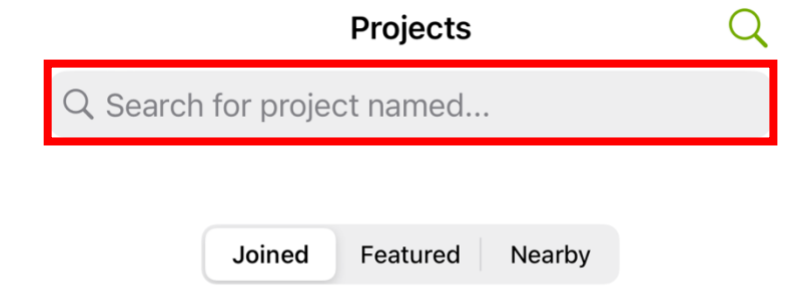

After you've made an account, you can join the Report Roadkill BC project. After signing in, you will likely see a map. This is the 'Explore' tab, which you can see on the bottom left. To join Report Roadkill BC, select the 'Projects' tab in the bottom right.



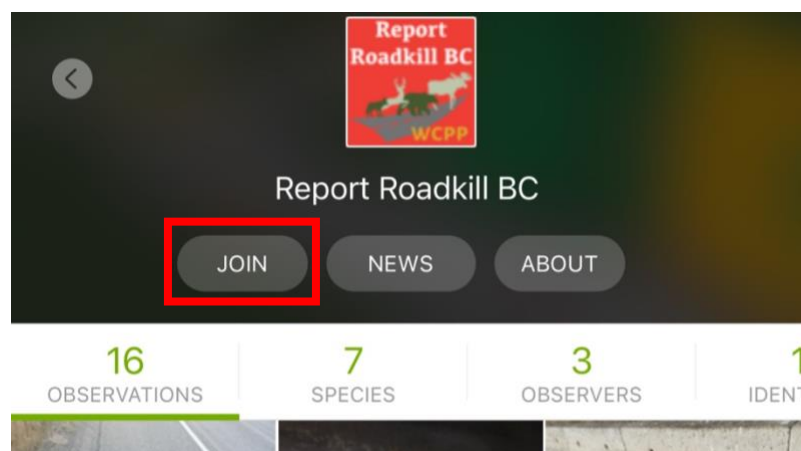
Once you're in the Projects tab, there will be search bar that says, 'Search for a project named...'. Tap on it and type in Report Roadkill BC.



Two projects, Report Roadkill BC, and Report Roadkill BC Public, should be visible. Select 'Report Roadkill BC'.



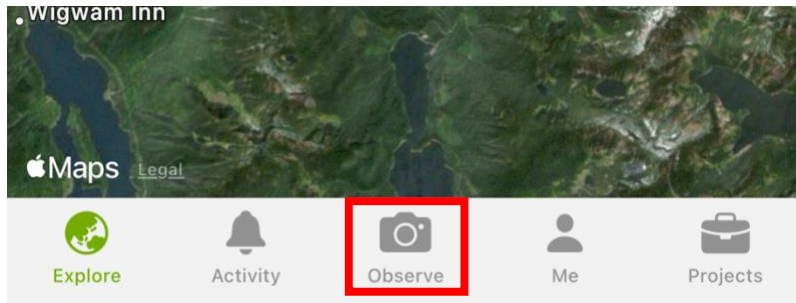
This will bring you to the project's main page. From there, you can join the project by selecting 'Join'.



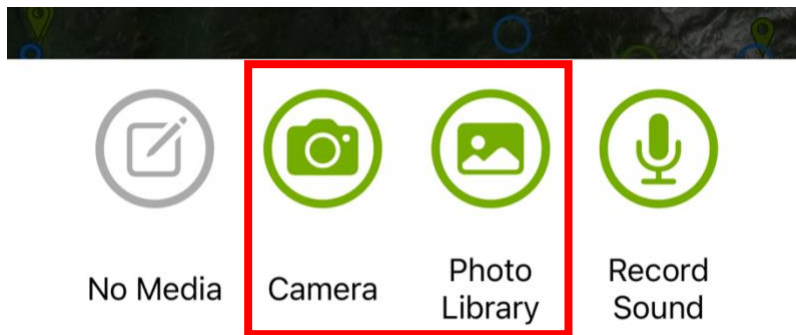
You've now joined the project and can start uploading observations!

Uploading observations to Report Roadkill BC

Once you're signed into your account, select 'Observe' at the bottom of the screen.




You can then select whether you want to take a picture or upload an image from your photo gallery. You can upload multiple images at once if you'd like to submit multiple observations.




Once you've selected the images you would like to upload, they will open in a new page where you can add additional details. Add information such as the date you *observed* the roadkill, the location, and the species. If you're not sure what the species is, you can put whatever you do know. (For example: you take an image of roadkill, but you can't identify the species. You can see a wing and feathers, so you know it's a bird. You put 'Birds' in the species spot.) Also be sure to add 'Roadkill' in the notes section.


Once you're happy with the information you've added, you can select Projects and it should show Report Roadkill BC. You can then select 'Share'.
